Summer Student Ministry Internship Program

Benefits/goals:

- 1. Develop the younger generation of ministry leaders
- 2. Support New Hope student ministry staff in planning, preparing, and leading summer trips, special events, and weekly ministry
- 3. Relationally and spiritually invest in our middle and high schoolers more effectively through one-on-one contact work
- 4. Attract New Hope's college-age students to return for ministry training

- <u>Category & Compensation</u>:This would be a full-time, 10-week summer internship, without employee benefits
 - \$4,000 (\$2,000 covered by the church, \$2,000 support raised by the intern) (note: \$700 is budgeted in Student Ministry for intern expenses)
 - Free housing **provided by NHP family*

Length of internship: 10 weeks; late May - early August

Primary role of intern:

- Contact work/building relationships with middle and high school students in one-on-one and group settings
- Supporting the Student Ministry staff in planning and leading events, trips, and weekly ministry



<u>Summer 2020</u> Student Ministry Internship <u>Information</u>

Purpose:

To assist the student ministry staff and leadership in encouraging, equipping, and empowering the middle and high school students of New Hope Church to build authentic relationships with Jesus and with others that will lead to an active life of faith in God, witness to Him, and service to others. To develop and hone one's own ministry gifts, skills, and calling through discipleship, mentorship, and training.

Responsibilities:

- Student contact work (attending student extracurricular events, meeting one-on-one with students, getting small groups of students together to hang out, etc.)
- Personal development under the guidance of the student ministry staff and/or others (personality, spiritual gifts, Strengths Finder, calling, etc.)
- Spiritual development under the guidance of an older man/woman (mentorship, discipleship)
- Professional development work under the guidance of the student ministry staff (read a student ministry book, plan and lead a creative student event, complete a self-evaluation at the end of the summer & receive feedback from student ministry staff, etc.)
- Assist the student ministry staff in leading the middle school mission trip to Chattanooga and the high school mission trip to Alabama
- Teach occasionally on Sunday mornings in student ministry

NEW HOPE PRESBYTERIAN · EPC

- Help plan and lead mid-week student ministry events (5-7 events throughout the summer)
- Participate in VBS alongside staff and student and adult volunteers
- Attend weekly staff meetings

Category & Compensation:

- This is a full-time, 10-week summer internship program, without employee benefits
- \$4,000 (\$2,000 covered by the church, \$2,000 support raised) *
- Free housing (living with a New Hope family or empty-nest couple)
- Budget money available to be used for student contact work

Length of internship:

10 weeks; late May - early August (specific dates TBD between Director and potential intern)

Qualifications:

- Must have completed 1 year of college by the time the internship begins
- A personal faith story that reflects a relationship with Jesus and reliance on Scripture (this should be evident in one's lifestyle and relationships)
- Flexibility and confidence to engage with students and their families in a variety of settings
- A valid driver's license
- A reliable source of transportation
- Ability to lift and carry 40 pounds
- Must pass a background check
- Must complete internship application and phone (or inperson) interview with student ministry staff

RE: Recommendation to change the Check Signing authority

It is being recommended for Session's review and approval, Beginning April 1, 2020, the Treasurer and Trustees of New Hope Presbyterian Church of Southwest Florida, Inc become the check signers for the Church.

Rationale:

From early in the church's life, checks have been signed by a group of people, including the church's treasurer and 3 members-at-large. These persons have been chosen by the Finance ministry team from the general church population and their names forwarded to Session for notification. They serve until resignation. While this system has worked for 12+ years, we believe that this system should be replaced by asking our Trustees to sign checks as part of their ministry to New Hope.

Trustees are voted into office by the congregation and hold legal standing for the corporate affairs of the church. It seems prudent that as legal representatives of the congregation under the direction and authority of Session that they should be the ones signing checks. Because the church's treasurer is part of our corporate filing (President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer), that person would be included in the check-signing group. We would, therefore, continue the use of four signers.

We can easily make this change through new signature cards being filed with each of our banks.

JANUARY-FEBRUARY Report in Student Ministry

- 1. Zack Unkenholz--our new Assistant Director of Student Ministry has begun and is getting settled in!
- 2. We still need additional adults to volunteer during the Sunday morning hour with students.
- 3. We hosted a High School only pizza movie game night on January 19 and had record attendance for a high school event--students had a wonderful time playing game together.
- 4. We took 67 students and leaders to Suncoast Student Retreat in Lake Placid, FL and students had great small group discussions with leaders and built connections with one another and the Lord.
- 5. We had our first "Small Group Serve Night" on February 12: all the student small groups (9 groups, 70 people total) chose a service project or local mission partner to support. Groups delivered cookies to local first responders, made valentine goodie bags for the church staff, purchased supplies for Verity Pregnancy Resource Center, did yard work at a church member's home, and much more!
